YOUTH SERVICES

CIRCULATION

• Shelving staff completed the shift in Adult Fiction, improving access to the collection as materials are no longer shelved on the bottom shelf.

INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY & FACILITIES

- Staff completed first phase of the new network backup system.
- Staff started a testing and usage project of Chromebooks.
- Security Camera System Upgrade:
 - o Honeywell completed installation of the new camera's and servers.
 - Honeywell is working to complete the camera configurations and training in January.

- Staff tile scrubbed all facility restroom tile.
- Staff installed new LED bulbs to replace the existing florescent lighting in the IT and Facilities workroom as a test program.
- Staff repainted several areas of the library.

OUTREACH

- Department Head, Carol Brandon, retired effective December 1st and new manager, Angela Clarke, is becoming oriented to new position.
- Bookmobile began a two week hiatus on December 25th. During the off-road time, staff
 weeded the collection, cleaned the Bookmobile and Outreach office, and continued to deliver
 homebound materials and process hold requests.

ADULT SERVICES

- The Web Redesign team is working on developing a test survey for the new website.
- Co-Managers attended the LAMPS meeting at the Lake Forest Public Library on Wed., 12/6.
- We purchased 2 additional telescopes from the Lake County Astronomical Society in prep for circulating telescopes for the public.
- Staff have been working on a social media campaign to boost awareness of WNPL library staff
 through a #iknowalibrarianwho campaign that has created a lot of engagement in our social
 media accounts.
