Good morning,

As you might recall, FYI, 3031 is a proposed new policy that is necessary due to a change in the Illinois Liquor Control Act. While we have always been able to serve alcohol at an event like Bingo in the Books by obtaining a temporary liquor license permit through the Village, this ability has not always been available to all Library Districts in Illinois. The change in the Act now allows for this, but it also calls for Library Districts to have a “written policy” for serving alcoholic beverages according to Roger Ritzman. Note that a temporary liquor license permit still must be obtained through the Village for any events at the library with alcohol, which are and will continue to be very rare and limited. Right now, the only event where we serve alcohol is our annual Bingo in the Books fundraiser.
