Attached is the current draft of our phased building reopening plan. This will provide you with a big picture overview of how we see the path to resuming physical services at WNPL as we slowly work our way back to normal service. This is very much a work in progress and subject to change based on new information becoming available. We haven't established a firm date yet to offer contactless pickup because that date depends on a number of factors, although I am hopeful this service can start in June, which generally falls in line with the same timeline our Lake County library peers are following. Right now we are hyper-focused on Phase 1 and making sure staff have the knowledge and equipment they need to safely return to the library. I can elaborate on our Phase 1 progress more on Tuesday night.
