### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

### Highlights:

- Celebrated National Library Week virtually with the theme of "Explore a New Chapter with Your Library." Communications asked a new question each evening on our Facebook page. "What Was Your Favorite Book as a Child?" was a clear favorite with 1305 people reached and 180 engagements. Also popular were a Dill Pickle Safe at Home coloring sheet and a WNPL Bookmobile cutout. A video montage of the staff photos collected for the social media effort was a highlight of the week.
