Attached is the latest revised draft of Policy 307 Sick Leave Benefits. The major change to this policy is that it simplifies the way that sick leave benefits accrue. Instead of having odd decimal accruals each month for certain employees (i.e., someone working 21 hours accruing 4.2 hours per month), we have rounded up to every half hour. This makes sense as we are proposing that staff must take sick leave in 30 minute increments. This change will make it much easier for us to track and administer sick leave.
